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1. University Information

"Fan S. Noli" University (UNIKO) is a public higher education institution located in Korçë, a city in the south-east of Albania. The university traces its origins to the Higher Agricultural Institute established in 1971 and began operating under its current structure in 1992. In 1994, the institution was officially named after the distinguished Albanian scholar, diplomat, statesman, and writer "Fan S. Noli".

Today, UNIKO serves as a leading center for higher education, scientific research, and innovation in the region. The university is committed to academic excellence, lifelong learning, and the development of an inclusive environment that promotes critical thinking, creativity, civic engagement, and intercultural dialogue.

With more than 120 cooperation agreements with higher education institutions and organizations worldwide, UNIKO actively promotes internationalization through academic exchanges, collaborative research projects, conferences, seminars, and professional development initiatives. The university continuously works to strengthen its international partnerships and enhance opportunities for students, researchers, and staff to engage in global academic networks.

As an active participant in the Erasmus+ Programme and other European educational initiatives, UNIKO offers extensive opportunities for international mobility and academic cooperation. Over the years, hundreds of students and academic staff members have benefited from mobility experiences abroad, contributing to the university's continuous development and international profile. These experiences have enriched teaching and learning practices, fostered the exchange of knowledge and cultures, and strengthened the university's commitment to European values and international collaboration.

Located in the historic and culturally rich city of Korçë, often referred to as the cultural capital of Albania, UNIKO offers international visitors the opportunity to experience a welcoming academic community while discovering the country's traditions, heritage, and contemporary life. Through its strong commitment to quality, internationalization, and community engagement, the university continues to play a significant role in the educational, social, and economic development of the region.

2. Academic Structure

"Fan S. Noli" University offers a diverse range of professional, undergraduate, master's, and doctoral programs designed to equip students with the knowledge, skills, and competencies required in today's global society.

The university currently comprises four faculties and fifteen academic departments, serving approximately 2,500 students. The academic staff includes approximately 150 full-time lecturers, ensuring high-quality teaching and personalized academic support.

Since its establishment, more than 35,000 students have graduated from UNIKO.

In recognition of its commitment to quality assurance and continuous improvement, "Fan S. Noli" University was accredited in 2017 for a five-year period by the British Quality Assurance Agency (QAA).

Our academic programs are supported by experienced faculty members, modern teaching methodologies, and a range of learning resources, including libraries, laboratories, research centers, and academic advising services. 3. Visa and Residence Information

International students and staff are advised to verify visa and residence requirements before their arrival in Albania. Regulations may vary depending on nationality, duration of stay, and the purpose of the visit.

3.1 Visa Information

Foreign nationals may enter Albania without a visa if they possess:

- A valid multiple-entry Schengen visa that has previously been used in a Schengen Area country
- A valid residence permit issued by a Schengen Area member state
- A valid multiple-entry visa issued by the United States or the United Kingdom that has been previously used in the issuing country
- A valid residence permit issued by the United States or the United Kingdom
- Certain internationally recognized travel documents issued by European Union member states, including travel documents for refugees, stateless persons, and persons benefiting from international protection, in accordance with Albanian legislation

Citizens of European Union Member States may enter Albania provided that their passport remains valid for at least three months beyond the intended date of departure from Albania.

Participants whose nationality requires a visa for entry into Albania may need to obtain a Type D visa before arrival if they intend to stay for more than 90 days. A Type D visa allows the holder to enter Albania and subsequently apply for a residence permit.

Holders of valid long-term residence permits, and internationally recognized travel documents may benefit from additional entry facilities, according to Albanian legislation.

Important recommendation: Incoming participants are encouraged to begin checking visa requirements and gathering the necessary documentation several months before departure. Processing times may vary depending on the country of residence and the individual circumstances of the applicant.

3.2 Residence Permit

International participants staying in Albania for more than three months are required to apply for a residence permit within 30 days of arrival. The application process is carried out through the Local Directorate for Border and Migration in Korçë.

For a residence permit for study purposes, applicants should prepare the following documents ([Ministria e Punëve të Brendshme](#)):

1. Application form
2. Copy of passport or national identity card
3. Recent passport-sized photographs (47 x 36 mm)
4. Proof of accommodation in Albania
5. Payment of the residence permit application fee (unless exempt under applicable legislation)
6. Valid Type D Visa
7. Official document from the home institution confirming participation in the Erasmus+ Programme
8. Proof of financial support (e.g., Erasmus+ grant agreement)
9. Proof of proficiency in the language of the study programme or the language used for teaching and learning, or a certificate confirming admission to a preparatory language course
10. Document confirming that the tuition fees or other fees established by the higher education institution have been paid.

Additional Information: Depending on the applicant's nationality and residence permit category, Albanian authorities may request additional supporting documents. Participants should ensure that all foreign-language documents are translated into Albanian by an authorized translator and that any required legalization or apostille procedures are completed before submitting the application.

Residence permit holders are responsible for maintaining a valid passport, providing updated contact information when required, and ensuring that their residence permit remains valid for the entire duration of their stay.

Assistance from UNIKO: The Projects, Scientific Training and Tertiary Services Sector at "Fan S. Noli" University assists incoming Erasmus+ students and staff by:

- Providing invitation and acceptance letters;
- Offering guidance on visa and residence procedures;
- Assisting with communication with local authorities when necessary;
- Supporting participants in completing administrative requirements related to their mobility period.

4. Accommodation

Finding suitable accommodation is an important part of your mobility experience. Korçë offers a variety of affordable housing options, including university dormitories, guesthouses, apartments, and hotels.

4.1 University Dormitory

"Fan S. Noli" University, in cooperation with "Trajtimi i Studentëve" sh.a., offers accommodation opportunities in student residence facilities, subject to availability.

The residence provides a safe and supportive living environment, with 24/7 on-site supervision and security camera monitoring. Facilities include internet access, shared cooking areas, laundry services, and parking, all covered by the monthly accommodation fee of 7,000 ALL (approximately EUR 70). If you choose to stay with a roommate, the monthly accommodation fee for a double room is 5,000 ALL (approximately EUR 50) per person.

Incoming students participating in mobility programs are encouraged to contact the Projects Office well in advance of their arrival to inquire about accommodation availability and reservation procedures.

The other campus, home to the Faculty of Natural & Human Sciences, is located on the other side of the city (approximately 30 minutes on foot).

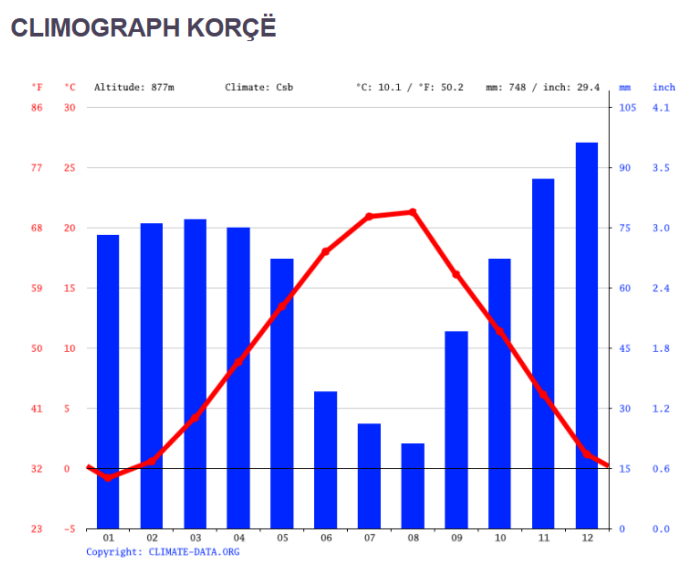
5. Practical Information before Departure

5.1 Climate

Korçë enjoys a continental-Mediterranean climate characterized by warm, dry summers and cold winters.

- **Average annual temperature:** approximately 10.6°C
- **Warmest months:** June through August
- **Coldest months:** December through February
- **Highest precipitation:** November

Note: Visitors are advised to bring clothing suitable for seasonal conditions.



5.2 Currency and Typical Expenses

The official currency of Albania is the Albanian Lek (ALL). Official exchange rates are available through the [Bank of Albania](#).

Banknotes: 200 ALL, 500 ALL, 1,000 ALL, 2,000 ALL, 5,000 ALL, 10,000 ALL

Korçë remains one of the most affordable university cities in Albania, offering a high quality of life at relatively low living costs. Some typical expenses include:

5.3 Banking, Mobile Services and Electricity

Foreign citizens may open a bank account in Albania. Several licensed commercial banks operate throughout the country. For further details, consult the Bank of Albania's list of licensed institutions.

Standard Operating Hours: Monday through Friday, 08:30 to 15:00

The two main mobile operators in Albania are **One Albania** and **Vodafone Albania**. SIM cards can be purchased easily in Korçë by presenting valid identification.

- **Voltage: 230V**
- **Frequency: 50Hz**
- **Plug Types: C and F** (Participants from countries using different plug systems should bring an adapter).

6. Transportation

6.1 Traveling from Tirana International Airport to Korçë

Korçë is located approximately 200 km southeast of Tirana and can be reached in about 3.5 to 4.5 hours, depending on traffic and weather conditions.

Visitors have several transportation options:

Option 1: Airport to Tirana Bus Terminal to Korçë (Budget Option)

This is the most economical way to travel to Korçë. Travel from Tirana International Airport to the Tirana Regional Bus Terminal via taxi or airport shuttle, then take an intercity bus from Tirana to Korçë. Buses operate daily, with departures beginning in the early morning and continuing until 17:00.

Approximate Costs: Airport to Bus Terminal: EUR 10–20 (Taxi) | Tirana to Korçë bus: EUR 5–8
| Total: EUR 15–28

Option 2: Direct Private Transfer

A taxi or private transfer can take you directly from Tirana International Airport to Korçë.

- **Travel time:** ~3.5 to 4 hours
- **Approximate cost:** EUR 120 per vehicle

Option 3: Car Rental

Several international and local car rental agencies operate at Tirana International Airport. Renting a car offers flexibility for travelers wishing to explore Albania independently before arriving in Korçë.

6.2 Traveling to Korçë by Car

If you are travelling to Korçë by car, you can enter Albania through several international border crossings, depending on your route and country of departure:

- **From Montenegro:** Muriqan – Sukobin | Hani i Hotit – Bozaj | Vermosh – Grncar
- **From Kosovo:** Morine – Vermice | Qafe Morine – Gjakove | Orgjost – Gllloboqice
- **From North Macedonia:** Qafe Thane | Tushemisht – Sveti Naum | Blate – Spas
- **From Greece:** Kakavije | Kavsticë | Qafe Bote – Sagiada | Tre Urat – Melissopetra

Korçë is easily accessible by road from many European destinations, with travel times and distances varying according to the chosen route and country of origin. Visitors travelling from Western Europe typically reach Korçë via Croatia and Montenegro; for example, Dubrovnik is approximately 400 km away, with a driving time of around 6 to 7 hours. Travellers from Bosnia and Herzegovina generally pass through SC Spojan Polje into Montenegro and continue via Niksic and Podgorica, while Sarajevo is located approximately 550 km from Korçë, representing a journey of around 8 to 9 hours. Those arriving from Central and Eastern Europe commonly travel through Serbia and Montenegro before continuing south towards Korçë.

6.3 Transportation In and Out of Korçë

Korçë is a compact, safe, and highly walkable city, allowing easy access to university facilities, accommodation, cultural attractions, shops, and essential services on foot. For longer journeys within the city, taxis are widely available and offer an affordable and convenient means of transportation.

Indicative Fare (City Centre/Bus Terminal to UNIKO): EUR 3 to 4 per vehicle

Public parking facilities are available throughout the city:

- **Paid parking areas:** ~EUR 0.50 per hour
- **Free parking spaces:** Available across various city locations based on availability

Korçë is well connected to both domestic and international destinations through regular bus services. The central bus terminal provides direct links to major Albanian cities, including Tirana, Elbasan, Pogradec, and Berat, as well as to key destinations in Greece such as Athens, Thessaloniki, and Larissa.

7. Restaurants

Korçë is renowned for its rich culinary traditions. The following highly recommended restaurants feature exceptional traditional Albanian, Mediterranean, and international cuisine near the campus area:

- **Taverna Vasili** (40.622780, 20.781864) — Renowned for its rustic atmosphere and authentic regional specialties.

- **Vila 95** (40.619534, 20.783348) — Blends contemporary dining with classic Albanian flavors (~1 km from the university).
- **Vila Cofiel** (40.612800, 20.785341) — Combines traditional hospitality with high-quality Mediterranean menus; highly popular with international guests.
- **ANTI-K Restaurant & Pizza** (40.619961, 20.783131) — Serving Italian pizza, pasta, seafood, and local options within close walking distance.
- **Restaurant Frogs (Zhabkat)** (40.623234, 20.778656) — Casual and traditional atmosphere with mixed Mediterranean flavors.
- **Shija e Saçit** (40.617840, 20.774950) — The perfect stop for authentic local dishes prepared using old regional recipes.
- **Secret Restaurant and Pizza** (40.619923, 20.782763) — Casual international dining spot focusing heavily on fresh artisanal pizzas.

Local Tip: A higher concentration of distinct cafes and bistros is located around the Old Bazaar and Bulevardi Shen Gjergji, roughly a 15 to 20 minute walk from campus.

The main public healthcare facility is the Regional Hospital of Korçë, located at Bulevardi "Fan Noli" 99, Korçë. The hospital operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and can be contacted at 127 or +355 82 242 755.

Specialized maternity services are provided by the Maternity Hospital of Korçë, situated on Rruga "Partizani", Korçë. The facility is also available 24/7 and can be reached at +355 82 243 130.

Both facilities provide essential healthcare services and emergency care, ensuring medical assistance is available to residents and visitors at all times.

9. City Guide

9.1 Discover Korçë: The Cultural Heart of Southeastern Albania

As the largest city in southeastern Albania, Korçë is widely regarded as one of the country's most charming, historic, and culturally vibrant centers. This rich cultural legacy is reflected in its unique architecture, well-preserved historic neighborhoods, and welcoming atmosphere, providing an ideal setting for international students, researchers, and academic staff to experience Albanian culture firsthand.

At the historic heart of the city lies the Old Bazaar. Dating back to the late fifteenth and early sixteenth centuries, this area beautifully reflects Korçë's Ottoman and European influences. Over the centuries, the city has seamlessly blended tradition, heritage, and gastronomy with modern urban life, developing into a vibrant center of commerce, culture, and intellectual life that eagerly awaits your discovery.

9.2 Top Architectural & Cultural Sites to Visit

1. Resurrection of Christ Orthodox Cathedral

One of the most iconic landmarks in Albania, the Resurrection of Christ Orthodox Cathedral is the largest Orthodox cathedral in the country. Built in 1995, it features impressive Byzantine Revival architecture, elegant frescoes, and a spacious interior that attracts visitors from across Albania and beyond.



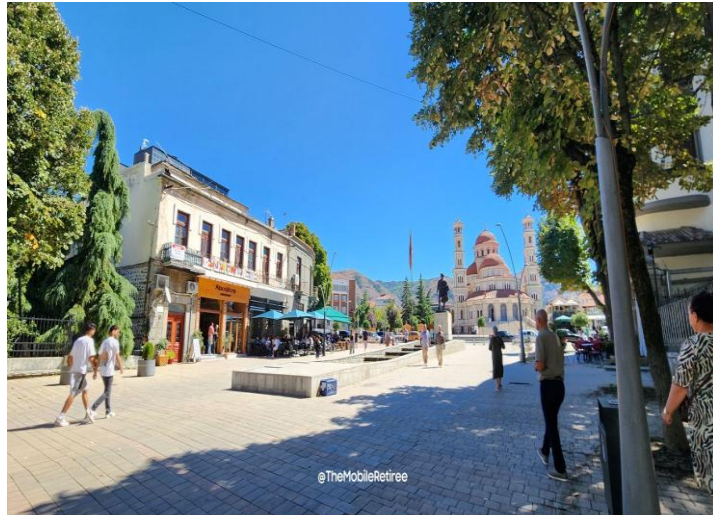
2. The Old Bazaar

The Old Bazaar is considered the cultural and historical heart of Korçë. Carefully restored in recent years, this charming district features traditional Ottoman-style architecture, cobblestone streets, artisan shops, cafes, restaurants, and cultural venues. Walking through the Old Bazaar offers visitors a unique opportunity to experience the city's rich history while enjoying local cuisine and traditional craftsmanship.



3. “Shen Gjergji” Boulevard

One of the city's most popular promenades, “Shen Gjergji” Boulevard is lined with cafes, restaurants, shops, and green spaces. It serves as a social hub for residents and visitors alike and is an excellent place to relax, meet friends, or enjoy an evening walk.



4. The Red Tower

The Red Tower has become one of Korçë's distinctive landmarks. Visitors can enjoy panoramic views of the city and surrounding mountains, making it an excellent location for photography and sightseeing.



5. “Gjon Mili” Photography Museum

Dedicated to the world-renowned photographer Gjon Mili, this museum celebrates the life and achievements of one of the twentieth century's most innovative photographers. Born in Korçë in 1904, Gjon Mili later emigrated to the United States, where he became internationally recognized for pioneering the use of electronic flash photography to capture movement. The museum houses a

collection of his most celebrated works and offers insight into his remarkable artistic legacy. Located in the historic “Romanian House” in the city center, the museum is a must-visit destination for photography enthusiasts and culture lovers.



6. Iljaz Bey Mirahori Mosque

Constructed in 1494, the Iljaz Bey Mirahori Mosque is one of Albania's most important religious and architectural monuments. Considered the first dome mosque built in the country, it represents a significant example of early Ottoman architecture in Albania. The mosque was designated a Cultural Monument in 1948 and remains one of the most historically significant landmarks in Korçë.



7. National Museum of Education

“The First Albanian School” opened in 1887, this historic building housed the first school in Albania where education was conducted in the Albanian language. Today, the museum serves as a symbol of the Albanian national awakening and the development of Albanian-language education. Visitors can explore exhibits related to the country's educational history and cultural heritage.



8. National Museum of Medieval Art

The National Museum of Medieval Art is among Albania's most significant cultural institutions. Established in 1980, the museum preserves approximately 7,000 artifacts of exceptional historical and artistic value, including icons, religious manuscripts, textiles, metalwork, and wood carvings dating from the 13th century onwards. The collection features works from some of the most celebrated iconographers of the Balkans, including Onufri, David Selenica, Jeromak Shpataraku, and the Zografi Brothers. The museum offers an outstanding introduction to Albania's rich artistic and religious heritage and is highly recommended for visitors interested in history, culture, and art.



9. Korçë Brewery

Founded in 1928, Birra Korça is Albania's oldest brewery and one of the city's best-known brands. The brewery has become an integral part of Korçë's identity and hosts the famous annual Korça Beer Festival, one of the largest cultural events in Albania.



10. Kamenica Tumulus

Located near Korçë, the Kamenica Tumulus is one of the most important archaeological sites in the Balkans. Archaeological excavations have uncovered over 400 graves, hundreds of human remains, and thousands of artifacts dating from the Late Bronze Age through the Early Iron Age. The site provides valuable insights into prehistoric civilizations that inhabited the region over 2,500 years ago.



11. Digital Art Gallery of Korçë (GADK)

The Digital Art Gallery of Korçë (GADK) represents a modern cultural initiative that combines art, creativity, and technology. Developed through the collaboration of the Municipality of Korçë and the non-profit organization “8 Plus,” the gallery offers interactive exhibitions, immersive digital experiences, and innovative projects that explore the intersection of art and emerging technologies, including Artificial Intelligence (AI). GADK has quickly become a dynamic center for contemporary artistic expression and technological experimentation in Albania.



12. The Early Christian Basilica of Lin

The Early Christian Basilica of Lin is located on the western part of the Lin Peninsula and represents one of the most important monuments in Albania. The structure was decorated with multicolored mosaics featuring floral and geometric motifs, as well as Eucharistic scenes, characteristic of the Early Christian period.
