Quality remains the key of university activities in the coming years focusing on the significant impact on a regional, national or international social development.


I am convinced that the success of the university work, now more than ever, depends on the cooperation willingness to influence public policy making.

We aim for a university that promotes SUSTAINABILITY and QUALITY as both, development and integration strategies.
































"FAN S. NOLI" UNIVERSITY

The University must create, transmit, develop and protect knowledge through its teaching, scientific research and other educational services. **

"Fan S. Noli" University of Korça was first established after the approval of the Council of Ministers Nr.5, on January 07, 1992, based on the Higher Agricultural Institute (1971-1992) under the name "The Polytechnic University of Korça". It was composed of three main units:

Faculty of Agriculture, Faculty of Economics, and Faculty of Education. In 1994 it was given the name of one of the most significant figures of the Albanian history and culture, Fan Stilian Noli. Since then the University has broadened its educational and administrative structure.

The University has been acredited by a British Agency of Quality Assurance for a period of five years.

Actually, the University consists of 4 faculties:

The Faculty of Agriculture,
The Faculty of Economics, The
Faculty of Education and Philology and
the Faculty of Natural and Human
Sciences. The faculties are
organized in 14 departments and
research group (section group).

In 2009 the University opened a branch in the city of Pogradec. At the beginning it offered only one study program, *Tourism Management*, but it was soon followed by another one, that of *Elementary Education and English Language*, and from 2013 to 2014 it qualifies its students for the Elementary Education Grades I-VI.

The University has a lifelong learning center, as basic research and training unit whose mission is to train teachers of the pre-university system as well as qualified specialists in natural and human sciences. Part of the Faculty of Agriculture is a Didactic Experimental Economy, which possesses 33 ha, where the students and the pedagogues develop their scientific research and professional practice.

The studies in the University of Korca are organized in three levels according to the criteria of the Bologna Declaration:

- the first level: Bachelor with 180 credits;
- the second level: Professional Master with 90 / 120 credits; and, Master of Science 120 credits;
- the third level: Doctorate / PhD.

How does the Bologna process work?

The Bologna process is a series of university reforms that aim to ensure a transparent, comparable and coherent system of higher education, based on three levels: diploma-master-doctorate. The Bologna process dated on 19 June 1999, with the signing of the Declaration from 29 European Countries.

Since 2008 Albanian universities have undertaken a series of reforms for the

academic freedom of universities as well as for the free student mobility to other universities for the following reasons:

to exchange experience with other students abroad;

to change the study contexts;

to exchange educational and teaching experiences;

to integrate the study structure and systems;

to compare the learning achievements at different universities, by respecting the tradition and the priorities of each one.

The European Union has assessed the students' mobility as an important aspect of the cooperation between universities.

How does the equivalency work?

The European Union elaborated a new common evaluation system called *The European Transfer System* to compare and transmit quality. This system enables the measurement of learning achievements. The credit system that is the base of this declaration measures the work done by the student in order to achieve the objectives of the Study Program.



Marks from 4-10 measure the quality of the student's work, while credits measure the quantity of work done by the student. If a student wants to go to another partner university he must transfer his credits. The partner university should be part of the agreements that both institutions have signed.

The University of Korça has approximately 5000 students from all regions of Albania, who attend 22 full-time study programs of the first cycle Bachelor; 16 full-time Proffesional Master study programs; 3 programs in Master of Science and 1 Doctorate program at the Faculty of Agriculture. There are 157 full time lecturers (83 per cent of whom hold titles and degrees) and a considerable number of part time academic staff.

The admission of students at the first cycle in Fan S. Noli University

- Every individual who has successfully finished high school and has passed the state examinations, has the right to apply for the first study cycle at Korça University.
- Foreign students can study on the first cycle of the study programs, based on bilateral or multilateral agreements.





The admission of the students at the second cycle in Fan S. Noli University

All candidates who have finished a study program of the first cycle and have fulfilled the academic admission standards that are defined in the study program criteria of every faculty, have the right to apply for the registration in the study programs of Professional Master or Master of Science.

Only students who have finished the first cycle and have been awarded a diploma in this study programs, (as well as students from other universities who fulfill the criteria and want to pursue the second cycle studies) can participate in this study program according to the respective profiles.

The admission of the students in the study program "Professional Master" is done during Fall. The applications are submitted at the secretary. Within one week from the time of applications, the Faculty Evaluation Committee reviews applications and provides relevant assessments.

Students cannot be transferred from one university to another within the same study program in the same academic year, but they may be transferred between programs of the same cycle, within the institution or other institutions of higher education, as well as from previous programs to other study programs of the first cycle.








The admission of the students at the third cycle

Doctoral study programs are programs of the third cycle with an academic nature, which are based on scientific research and creative activities; the candidates must have the university degree "Master of Science".

The doctoral studies are organized on the grounds of departmental research projects following the priorities of the unit. These studies last for at least three academic years.

The University Collegial bodies are: the Senate, the Board of Administration, the Rectorate and the Decanate.


The Academic Senate is the highest collegial body that defines the development policies of the institution. It compiles, coordinates, guides and monitors the teaching and research work of the university academic staff.



THE CURRICULA AND QUALITY ASSURANCE OFFICE

The internal quality assurance is realised through the evaluation network established at the university by means of the work of the quality assessment office and its units at the faculties.

The main functions of the internal quality assuarance unit are:

- preparation of the self-assesment annual report;
- establishment of reliable criteria for the external evaluation;
- training organization on quality issues and other functional competences of the staff.

Promotion of quality assurance and its improvement is focused on the students needs. It goes through the following stages:

- Support on the development of quality assurance processes.
- · Coordination of the self-assesment process.
- Monitoring and administration of the institutional process.
- Providing information on quality standards.

The quality standards aim to measure the degree in which the study programs at the university meet the criteria required by:

- the mission and the aim of the institution;
- · the needs of the labor market;
- the economic development of the country.









SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH

The UNIKO mission as defined in its status emphasis the creation, transmission, development and protection of knowledge through teaching, scientific research and services. This mission is accomplished through elaboration and implementation of policies, principles and procedures that supervise the financial and logistical support that UNIKO offers to its academic units. For this reason, the main aim of UNIKO supporting research structures is focused on the creation of institutional research mechanisms related to well-defined programs, clear priorities, and involvement of academic staff in quality research activities, without avoiding elements of the scientific product, publications, partnerships, marketing and services to third parties. The Scientific Research at UNIKO is based on standards defined by the European Research Area.

The main aim of responsible structures for academic research at institutional and academic level is reflected in the growth and consolidation of:

- -Human resources
- -Research Infrastructure
- -Regional and international cooperation
- -Relations to economy and society

The scientific research work is also promoted through periodic activities, scientific conferences, promotional posters, and by increasing interdisciplinary research. The scientific research is based on quality standards and tries to increase the research culture which will lead to the creation of research centers. Another important strategic objective is the establishment of an Innovation Center, which will serve as a cornerstone for scientific innovation, tracing new ideas, contemporary technologies, spin-offs and a tendency to connect with industry and research marketing.

THE FACULTY OF AGRICULTURE



Dean of the Faculty

The Faculty of Agriculture is the foundation stone of "Fan S. Noli" University. It was first estaclished on 15 June 1971, as the High Institute of Agriculture. In the following 20 years, this institution developed in spite of many political restrictions it had to go through. New academic concepts were introduced, new visions and university programs were constituted and new methods for the qualification of agriculture specialists were integrated with laboratory works and experimental practices.

Since 1992 the Faculty has gone through an entire conceptual and structural reformation, to cope with the social and educational transformations that occured with the change of political system in Albania. The reformation was done within the legal framework of the University status.

In this respect the first Master program "Integrated Rural Development" was opened in the academic year 2008-2009. It was very soon followed by the

Bachelor program "Technology of the Plant Production".

Well-equiped laboratories can be found within the premises of the Faculty of Agriculture: the laboratory of chemistry, the laboratory of microbiology, the laboratory of physiology, the laboratory of plant protection, the laboratory of pedology, the laboratory of the animal product, the laboratory of fitotechnology and agricultural extension, the laboratory of seed selection and production, the laboratory of agricultural mechanics, ect. All the laboratories are continuously updated and enriched with elements of the modern technology.

The students may also be trained and qualified in the Laboratory of the Standard Analysis as well as in Laboratory of the Microbiology and Food Analysis in the Directory of Hygiene and Epidermiology, in Korca.

The Faculty of Agriculture is the only university in Korça region that provides education and training in the fields of agro-bisness, agro-noutrition and agriculture. It consists of three units: The Department of Agronomy. the **Department** Horticulture of and Agrobusiness and the Department of Biochemistry and Agro-noutrition. The Faculty also offers the only PhD program at the University in Sustainable Horticulture, a program that was first opened in 2011.

The Mission of the Faculty of Agriculture




















FACULTY OF EDUCATION AND PHILOLOGY

The Faculty of Education and Philology was first established with a decree of the Ministry of Education and Science, based on the Constitution Act nr. 102 and the Article nr. 41 of the University Education Law in the Republic of Albania. This laid the foundation of the Education Faculty that was first opened in 1992. Since that time on, 4375 students have been graduated in its study programs.

OBJECTIVES OF THE STUDY PROGRAMS OF THE FACULTY OF EDUCATION AND PHILOLOGY

The Faculty of Education and Philology has supplied the eagerness of Korça region for the teaching methodology and qualified staff needs in different fields. Since the region reflects a continuous love for education, this Faculty (ex-Faculty of Education) has supplied the schools of the region with different profiles teachers for more than 13 years.

As a cradle of young teachers education, this Faculty has maintained through years

its collaboration with the Regional Education Directory of Korça and the Education Offices within Korça district. Furthermore, it has enhanced its communication with them through the organization of common activities of reciprocal interest.

- to prepare motivated teachers, ready to serve the development of different regions.


These objectives can only be reached through continuous work and update of the following aims of the study programs:

COURSE OBJECTIVES WITHIN THE STUDY PROGRAM FRAMEWORK

- Prividing students with appropriate theoretical and practical teaching knowledge in order to help them increase the education standards in primary, secondary and high schools to fit the learners age charachteristics, the particular features of education in Albania and the role of the teacher in a changing social context.

- Increasing the students ability to solve problematic issues of the educational context.
- Supplying an accademic context of educational issues, currently emerging in the national and international discussion in order to shape the future theoretical perspective and the specific professional attitude of the teachers-to be. The courses are countinously updated to include the current trends of the communication and teaching technology.
- Training students to increase their professional skills throught testing, classroom management, learning strategies, research and lifelong learning.
- Providing practical skills for the students through using interactive learning tools during the discussion classes and the management of the fieldwork period in the schools.
- Enhancing critical thinking and data evaluation in specific fields of the teaching and learning framework and increasing the




student's awareness in terms of personal responsability and independent research work, by making a good use of the information souces (dictionaries, internet websites, didactic manuals, ect.)

The above objectives are all reflected in the syllabuses of the study programs of the Faculty of Education and Philology, in order to prepare and train professional teachers that could satisfy the needs of the public and private labour market.

The Faculty of Education and Philology offers modern infrastructure that satisfies the teaching, learning and research needs. There are eight lecture halls equipped with video projectors, one amphitheater, one video-conference room, one Foreign Languages Laboratory, one Laboratory for the Experimental Phonetics and Speech Pathology, 75 computers for the academic staff and the students. The library of the faculty "Kongresi i Manastirit" offers 20.000 titles of academic books in Albanian and other languages, as well as the access to use online libraries of universities abroad.

The Faculty has already organized 7 international scientific conferences and it maintains reciprocal cooperation with 12 homologous faculties in Albania, in the Balkans and in Europe. Well-known personalities of the Albanian and European academic world have been invited to share their knowledge and experience with the teaching staff and students of the Faculty.

The Faculty of Education and Philology publishes "Scipta manent", a periodic reflection of the research work of its academic staff and of the proceedings of the conferences it organizes.





THE CENTER OF EXCELLENCE

On 24 July 2012, the Commission of the Training Programs Accreditation entitled the CENTER OF EXCELLENCE, in the Faculty of Education and Philology, to train the staff of the educational institutions in 32 modules of about 95 credits for all the profiles of the teachers already in service.

THE MISSION OF THE CENTER

THE CENTER OF EXCELLENCE intends to develop training and qualification activities for the teachers. It mainly focuses on enhancing teaching and innovation skills in education, in methods and practices used by the professional teachers, in rebuilding the social concept of the collaboration with school, etc.

The Center is the main training institution for the qualification of the teaching staff in the schools of Korça region and further. It maintains a continuous collaboration with the Directory of Education and the Education Offices in the area. It offers training programs for eight teaching profiles and helps them to improve their professional qualifications and apply them in their teaching experience.

The Center can be found within the premises of the Faculty of Education and Philology (the video conference room, nr. 334, 3rd floor). It offers a modern infrastructure appropriate for the



The Center is managed by a qualified staff of experienced lecturers of each of the departments of the Faculty as well as of other educational and administrative institutions.
























The teaching process is based on the scientific research and the professional



THE DEPARTMENT OF NURSERY

The Department of Nursery was established in October 1994, under the Ministry of Health care. At the time it had 65 students and 7 physicians as teaching staff. In 1995, it became the Nursery Branch of the "Fan S. Noli" University, since it fulfilled all the requirements of a graduate school. The main aim of the school was to train nurses with higher educational qualification. In the first four years, teaching was carried out by doctors and professors of the former Medical High School in order to involve more qualified people in teaching. In 2005, a new program of the first cycle was opened: Nursing and Midwives and in 2010. The General Nursing program was offered even in the part-time system. Two years later, the Faculty opened the Professional Master in General Nursing to complete the qualification of the students in this field.

The mission of the Department of Nursery is to achieve professional and scientificeducation of students in the highest quality through advanced educational programs and scientific research.

The main objective of this department is the preparation of qualified nurses to successfully cope with the labor market needs and challenges of the healthcare sector in its three levels and in the community welfare as well.

The Department of Nursery offers study programs of first level in:

knowledge on the methods of general scientific principles and specific professional skills in the field of nursing. At the end of the study programs of General Nurse and Midwife (nursing) students receive basic theoretical, deontological, ethical and scientific knowledge as well as practical skills required in the field of medicine.

Second level studies:

continuous education and further professional qualifications of all students who have completed the first cycle of studies in general nursing or related fields.

Facilities and other services

The Faculty of Natural and Human Science conducts its teaching and research work in two buildings, the existing building of the School of Nursing and a newly reconstructed one.

The Faculty of Natural and Human Science occupies an area of 10251 m² the







main building area is 772.8 m² (a two store building) and the other building which includes a library and an internet center for students occupies an area of 162.9 m². In the main building there are 3 lecture halls with 50-80 seats, 6 classrooms for seminars; and 1 amphitheater with 140 seats. The lecture halls are equipped with video-projectors, which enable a comprehensive spread of information during the lessons.

Beside the auditors there are also 5 laboratories:

- 2 biology and chemistry labs
- 1 physics laboratory
- 2 informatics labs

In this building there is also the Centre of Civic Education which operates as a training center in the auspices of the Department of Social Sciences.

The Nursing School was build in the 90's. It is a new building destined for the Nursing School. It is located near the hospital of Korca District where students perform their teaching practice. The teaching area covers approximately 1800 m². The classrooms are designed to be used as laboratories. There are three lecture halls with a capacity of 50 seats, two seminar rooms, and seven laboratory classes as follows:

1 obstetrics - gynecology laboratory

2 anatomy - physiology laboratories

3 nursing laboratories

1 surgical laboratory

These facilities are equipped with the necessary materials for teaching such as posters, mannequins, literature, teaching medical equipment, medical instruments, visit beds, slides, television, video players and other facilities for the student accommodation.

The school also uses some laboratories of the university (biology, biophysics, biochemistry).

There is also a library, an informatics center, a secretary, a professor's hall, an office, an archive office, a student's hall etc. Currently the School of Nursing uses three lecture halls with a capacity of 40-60 students each. Other equipment used to develop lessons (depending on the method chosen by the pedagogue) as slides, photoprojectors, retroprojectors are taken from the library or laboratories.

The school library is a suitable reading and working environment for students and pedagogues. It has a capacity of 30 seats. It is equipped with books and other necessary equipment such as computers, printers, scanners and a TV video player.



The Faculty of Economy was opened in 1992. The first students were graduated in 1996. It was the transitional phase of the Albanian economy and its labor market that committed the academic staff of the University to found this Faculty; it would offer the theoretical and practical knowledge necessary to understand and update the function of the new developments. This faculty started its activity as a part of "Fan S. Noli" University with three study programs: Management, Marketing and Tourism in full time and part time programs. Based on the growing interest in this field, a new study program, Finance-Accounting, was opened in 1998. - Increasing the theoretical and practical skills needed in a professional career.


- **4.** Creating opportunities for the continuous qualification of the young specialists in the field of economy.


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














ACCOMODATION FACILITIES

Public buses are in use everyday for all the people. Taxis, which cost about 1.5 euros, can be used for the transport inside the city.
