INTRODUCTION

"Fan S. Noli" University is an institution of higher education which, over a period of fifty years, has standardized a competitive academic and scientific profile in the course of university education development in Albania. This university can be considered as one of the most important poles of educational, economic and social development in the southeast of Albania. Relying on values and tradition, preserved in time, currently, this university aims to offer sustainable standards, that orient academic and scientific activity towards new forms of teaching, research and development, in order to meet the challenges of living in an open society of constant evolution and demands. The vision of growth and development of this institution is oriented towards the European Higher Education Area, as an opportunity to increase professionalism and partnership in its academic offer.

Based on these premises, "Fan S. Noli" University has drafted its 6-year development strategy in order to determine the main development trends, forseen in a series of strategic objectives related to each other and the stakeholders involved in this process. The following Strategic Planning presents a summary of the process and methodology used, starting from the assessment of the current situation, the definition of the challenges and opportunities so far, the design of milestones for a common sustainable strategy, the definition of the role and function of the stakeholders. These elements are illustrated within the detailed strategic framework in the next six-year action plan of this university. This strategic planning is a dynamic document in continuous improvement and represents an open, comprehensive summary, reflecting the necessary updates in time. Governing bodies and authorities can use this document as a memorandum, measuring the gradual implementation of academic planninng in line with key development directions. The Strategic Plan that details the Development Strategy, guarantees the continuity and legitimacy of the latter at the institutional level for certain annual periods.

CURRENT SITUATION OF "FAN S. NOLI" UNIVERSITY

DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY AND ITS IMPORTANCE

This strategic document was drafted by the Rectorate of "Fan S. Noli" University on the basis of proposals received from the main units and basic units, on the main directions of activity for the period 2022-2027. The framework, in which higher education is offered in Albania, defines the universities not only as teaching centers, but as important poles of the development of the respective regions, through professional teaching and research in accordance with the needs of the market, cooperation with public and private stakeholders, as well as the increase of international partnership.

The Development Strategy of the University "Fan S. Noli" is based on the Statute of this University, the Strategic Plan for its development in the period 2016-2020, the National Strategy for Education 2021-2026, as well as the labor market requirements of Korça region and beyond. It also comes as a result of consultations with faculty, students, relevant administration sectors, key labor market actors in each major unit, and internal quality assurance reports in previous years. The Strategic Plan that follows is drafted on the details of the priorities of this Strategy in a comprehensive process of lines, action plans and provision of financial support for them.

In this strategic plan are taken into account the plans made by the respective units and faculties, as well as the proposals given by the Student Council, in order to maintain strategic compliance with the requirements of Law no. 80/2015 "On higher education and scientific research in institutions of higher education in the Republic of Albania", article 40 item 3, item 38 item b), item 49 point b). This plan provides mechanisms and instruments that are able to ensure full coherence of strategic objectives and actions needed to achieve the expected levels of results.

STRATEGIC PLANNING METHODOLOGY

The strategic planning of Fan S. Noli University is based on the following issues:

- 1. The analysis of the current situation of the University "Fan S. Noli" and elaboration of the SWOT analysis upon the light of the changes and results achieved by the strategic objectives set in its previous short / long term plans, including discussions in the basic units mentioned above.
- 2. Defining strategic and basic objectives in accordance with the indicators derived from the above-mentioned analysis.
- 3. Perputhja the goals of this plan with the mission and vision of "Fan S. Noli", University mainly focusing on improving the main institutional activities: education, research and internationalization.
- 4. Determining specific indicators of quantitative results, related to each basic objective.

- 5. Discussing the strategic map, created in cooperation with the Rectorate, Dean office the Student Council, in order to make possible changes.
- 6. Approving the final draft of the Strategic Development Plan of "Fan S. Noli" University 2022-2027, by the Board of Administration and the Academic Senate.

STRATEGIC FRAMEWORK MISSION AND VISION OF "FAN S. NOLI" UNIVERSITY

This document aims to identify the main priorities and the development objectives of "Fan S. Noli" University in the next six years. In addition to analyzing the current state of the institutional framework, this document also focuses on the objectives in order to increase the quality of academic services and the internationalization of the latter, the university's connection with the labor market and the assessment of the financial situation, in order to create optimal conditions for a sustainable development of this institution.

Mission of "Fan S. Noli" University:

"Fan S. Noli" is a public university and as such has the main mission to create, transmit, develop and protect knowledge through teaching, research and services in the fields of economics, agriculture, humanities and social sciences, natural sciences and education sciences.

Vision of "Fan S. Noli" University:

"Fan S. Noli" University aims to be the most important center of the academic and scientific life in Korça region, by directly contributing to the educational, economic and sustainable development of local, regional and wider communities, through the promotion of study programs recognized and open nationally and internationally to the students and researchers, focusing on the development of professional and research skills, to meet with dignity the demands of the labor market.

"Fan S. Noli" University is:

- an institution where the activity of students, professors, researchers, administrative and technical staff is closely related to the academic freedom in education and research, of thinking "different" and social responsibility;
- place of creation, development, transmission and protection of knowledge, which guarantees
 qualifications at levels 5-8 of the Albanian Qualifications Framework, as well as forms of
 continuing education;

a public academic institution, which continuously updates teaching, research and transfer of the knowledge for the benefit of the society, at the regional, national and international level TETHER

As mentioned above "Fan S. Noli" University realizes the mission through these objectives:

- To prepare skilled specialists for the labor market in the fields it covers in all study programs, through teaching and institutional, professional, sports, clinical and teaching practices;
- To train new researchers in various primary fields, taking into account the main directions of development of the region, through scientific research and publishing activity;
- To meet the standards in order to guarantee the teaching and scientific process in all the study cycles that it offers;
- To assist and support cultural and socio-economic development at the regional, national and international level, by promoting, organizing and performing cultural and educational services;
- To provide equal opportunities to benefit from higher education and lifelong learning.
- To contribute to economic, social and cultural development at national and regional level, as well as to strengthening public and national security;
- To support the strategic priorities and development interests of the country;
- To promote international cooperation in the field of higher education;
- To develop critical and analytical thinking, to cultivate a sense of responsibility and commitment of people, cultures, events and various issues related to the individual and the community;
- To prepare professionals and active citizens for the Albanian democratic society and for European values;
- To conduct scientific studies in order to develop the science study programs, that it provides
 and provide services for solving the most important problems in the Korça region and
 beyond;
- To provide the continuous qualification of senior specialists in various fields, becoming an important center of qualification and development of modern technologies.

"Fan S. Noli" University acts in line with:

- The fundamental human rights enshrined in the Constitution of the Republic of Albania;
- free development of study, scientific research, as well as cooperation at national and international level;
- spirit of cooperation with governmental or non-governmental institutions, businesses and enterprises, educational institutions, maintaining its status independent of any ideological, political or religious orientation;

- values related to ethnic and social diversity;
- the vision to prepare worthy professionals who will serve to a more inclusive every society.

HISTORY OF THE DEVELOPMENT OF "FAN S. NOLI" UNIVERSITY

"Fan S. Noli" University started its function as an institution of higher education in June 15, 1971, when the Higher Agricultural Institute of Korça was opened by the decision of the Council of Ministers. In the first academic year 1971-1972 were enrolled 43 students and by 1991 this Institute graduated about 1210 agricultural specialists. On the basis of the Higher Agricultural Institute, on January 7, 1992, by decision of the Council of Ministers, the University of Korça was established as the Polytechnic University of Korça, consisting of three main units: the Faculty of Agriculture, the Faculty of Economics and the Faculty of Pedagogy. In 1994 by the decision of the Council of Ministers no. 213, the University of Korça was named "Fan S. Noli". Since that year, "Fan S. Noli" University has expanded its teaching and administrative structure.

In May 2015, the President of the Republic of Albania, Mr. Bujar Nishani awarded to "Fan S. Noli" University of Korça the decoration "Honor of the Nation" for an outstanding contribution to the development of education, culture and science.

In December 18, 2001, "Fan S. Noli" University was honored by the President of the Republic, Mr. Rexhep Mejdani with the golden decoration "Naim Frashëri", for important contribution during 30 years in the preparation of senior specialists in agriculture, economics, education and health, for valuable achievements in research-experimental work, for a special role in the spread of culture in the region of Korça and beyond.

In 2017, during the Institutional Accreditation process, "Fan S. Noli" University was accredited for a 5-year period by the British Quality Assurance Agency. Currently, 9 study programs are in the process of accreditation, three of which were accredited with the maximum ratings.

CURRENT STRUCTURE OF "FAN S. NOLI" UNIVERSITY

In fulfillment of its academic mission, "Fan S. Noli" University consists of the following functional structures:

ACADEMIC STRUCTURE AT INSTITUTIONAL LEVEL:

• Academic Senate

The Academic Senate is the highest collegial decision-making body of "Fan S. Noli" University. It currently consists of nineteen members, two of whom are students. The Academic Senate makes decisions on important issues of the University in the field of teaching, research and administration, guaranteeing autonomy, academic freedom and student rights.

Bord of Administration

The Board of Directors is the highest governing / collegial administrative body. It guarantees the financial stability of "Fan S. Noli" University and the fulfillment of its mission. The Board of Administration of "Fan S. Noli" University consists of seven members, where one of them is elected by the students' vote. On the proposal of the Academic Senate, the Board of Administration approves the strategic development plan, the annual and medium-term budget, as well as the number of staff at all levels of the institution.

Rectorate

The Rectorate is a collegial body headed by the Rector and it consists of the Rector, Deputy Rectors, the administrator of the institution and the heads of the main units. He drafts the strategic development plan of "Fan S. Noli", University based on the proposals of the basic units and the main units of the university, as well as those of the administrator. It also compiles the program and the annual report of teaching-research activities, as well as the plan for collaborations and agreements that are under his competence.

• Rector

The Rector is the highest academic authority of Fan S. Noli", University, as well as its legal representative for academic and protocol issues. The Rector is elected by the members of the assemblies of the academic staff of the main units and the students of "Fan S. Noli" University. He is the head of the Academic Senate and a member of the Conference of Rectors of the Albanian Universities.

Administrator

The administrator of "Fan S. Noli" University is the highest administrative authority and he is also responsible for the financial situation of the university. The administrator is the legal representative of "Fan S. Noli" University for financial and administrative matters. He is responsible for drafting, monitoring and controlling the implementation of the annual budget of the University, as well as being responsible for all economic and financial activity of the university.

• Deputy Rectors

Fan S. Noli University consists of two Deputy -Rectors: the Deputy Rector Teaching and the Deputy-Rector in charge of Science and International Relations.

The Deputy Rector in charge of Teaching organizes and controls the teaching process at the university level, he follows the drafting and implementation of teaching plans and curricula in the main units and basic units, he drafts the structure of the academic year for the teaching process at university level and the annual report of teaching activity of "Fan S . Noli" University and he submits it to the Rector for approval.

The Deputy-Rector in charge of Science and International Relations monitors and she controls the progress of scientific work and projects at the university level, monitors the scientific cooperation of the units of "Fan S. Noli" University with scientific research institutions, other universities (inside and outside the country), production enterprises, etc., as well as she works on scientific studies for the perspective development in the field of research.

Council of Ethics

The Council of Ethics is a collegial body of "Fan S. Noli" University, which promotes and reviews issues related to ethics in the activity of the teaching and research process, as well as in other institutional activities. The Council of Ethics of "Fan S. Noli" University consists of 7 members (the Rector, one representative from each main unit, one student representative and one representative from the academic and administrative support staff). It works in a collegial way.

ACADEMIC STRUCTURES AT THE MAIN UNIT LEVEL:

- Assembly of academic staff;
- Dean's Office (headed by the Dean and it consists of the Dean, Deputy Dean, heads of basic the units);
- Dean;
- Deputy-Deans

ACADEMIC STRUCTURES AT THE BASIC UNIT LEVEL:

The head of the department is the academic managing authority and the representative of the basic unit. He manages all the teaching and scientific activity in the basic unit, prepares the distribution of the teaching workload that is approved in the basic unit, prepares and proposes to the naming bodies the study curricula of the basic unit, new directions and study profiles, projects for study programs and scientific research, etc., as well as he reports to the Dean and the Dean's Office about the progress of the teaching and research process in the basic unit.

ORGANIZATION AND ADMINISTRATIVE MANAGEMENT:

• The Directorate of Economy carries out the continuous administration of the procurement process, based on the legislation in force for procurement, as well as it manages the transport and maintenance needs of "Fan S. Noli University".

- The Directorate of Finance monitors all financial operations related to the expenses for the activity of "Fan S. Noli" University, staff payments in cooperation with the Legal and Muman. Resources Directorare, operative expenses and investments in cooperation with other units, as well as closes the annual balance sheet for the entire university. It also monitors the implementation of all the financial procedures for the implementation of the University budget, other budgets (services, donations, projects), maintaining relevant documentation in close contact with state financial bodies in implementation of laws and bylaws.
- The Internal Audit Unit implements the policy and strategy of "Fan S. Noli" University for the continuous development of the audit in achieving the standards.

- The Erasmus + Coordinator coordinates projects for capacity building and student / staff mobility within the Erasmus + program.
- The coordinator of the Continuing Education Center has the function of organizing and developing training and qualification activities for in-service teachers. The main directions of the work of this center are focused on the development of the teaching skills and innovation in education, in the ways and practices of professional development of teachers, etc.
- The Innovation Center aims to motivate students and young people, in general, towards entrepreneurship. "Fan S. Noli" University and the Innovation Center are always looking for new collaborations, with the priority of supporting young people in this regard.
- The Student Sports Association of "Fan S. Noli"University, located at Rectorate building, aims to promote sports in student life through the development of sports activities locally, nationally and internationally.
- The Student Council promotes and coordinates the participation of students and their representation in the governing bodies of the university, as well as in the teaching-research structures. The General Student Council of "Fan S. Noli" University and the Student Council of

each Faculty is elected by the vote of all students. The Student Council expresses opinion proposals on all issues of the general interest to the University.





STUDY OF THE ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE (2016-2020)

Studying the progress of the priority areas of the Strategic Development Plan of "Fan S. Noli" University, the improvement of the quality of the study programs, the opening and reorganization of study programs, the improvement of the curriculum based on learning outcomes, the improvement of quality of teaching; the following presents the continuity of the constituent elements of the teaching activity.

New admissions and study programs in the period 2016-2020

Currently at the University "Fan S. Noli" 3500 students continue their studieS from all districts of Albania and from Albanian lands.

At the University "Fan S. Noli" teach 157 effective lecturers, of which 5 professors, 29 associate professors, 75 doctors of science, 7 professors and 41 others. In the academic years 2016-2020 the number of part-time lecturers has varied between 96 and 136.

Year after year, the staff / student ratio is influenced by the total number of students and for each study program has resulted within the criteria (according to the relevant DCM for the standards of staff / student ratio). The new admissions regardfing the period 2016-2020 have undergone continuous changes in both quantitative and qualitative direction. Changes in bylaws, related to the average grade criteria, as well as the decrease in the number of graduates from year to year has led to a continuous change in the number of students at the HEI level. This has been the main reason that has affected the inputs of each year, even though the promotional activities are regularly conducted for each year.

Based on the data of new admissions for 5 academic years, there is a decrease in admissions from the beginning to the end of the period, with the exception of the academic year 2018-2019, due to the activation of 14 new study programs. In the following years, the number of students continues to decline, being reflected in the total number of students according to the table below.

During the academic year 2019-2020, the University "Fan S. Noli" faced a difficult challenge in terms of the progress of the teaching process. Isolation as a result of the pandemic from the Covid-19 virus, created new requirements on the way of organizing teaching/learning processes mainly based on online teaching. Based on the best practices brought by the academic staff, as well as the need for new ways of teaching, important measures were taken for the organization of the teaching process through online learning platforms. After the first period of online teaching and learning (second semester of the academic year 2019-2020) all the necessary measures were taken to implement a unified platform for all academic staff, before the start of the new academic year 2020-2021.

- The start of the new academic year 2020-2021 found the academic staff prepared to organize the teaching processes through online platforms.

More pecifically, a lot of training sessions, based on a project, were organized, on the possibilities provided by the MIRCOSOFT OFFICE 365 package, which also includes the MICROSOFT TEAMS platform. The whole academic year was organized on the basis of this platform, as a successful way that can be used in the future.

- Subscription to the online library was already enabled.
- The "Cleanscore" project was implemented as an evaluation format for students.

New study programs, reorganizations (trends):

The opening of the new study programs or their reorganization is an ongoing process of development of "Fan S. Noli" University, responding to market needs for professions required on the one hand and updating requirements according to changes in the labor market on the other hand.

The amendments to the law on higher education in 2015 and the new needs of the labor market led the "Fan S. Noli University" to the demand for the opening / reorganization of study programs. Pursuant to the new law on higher education, the study programs of the second cycle Master study programs were adapted, from 90 credits to 60 or 120 credits and in 2019 it was approved by MESY (MESY requisition no. 1287/1, dated 15.03. 2019).

Pursuant to the strategy for the development of "Fan S. Noli University" it is applie, every year, in MESY for the opening / reorganization of study programs, namely:

In 2017, it was applied for 2 study programs, approved by MESY:

- "Professional Master" in "Public Administration" (Department of Social Sciences);
- 2-year professional study program "Education for infancy and early childhood" (Department of Education).

In 2017, it was applied for 14 study programs, approved by MESY:



- 2-year Professional Study Program "Agricultural Business Management";
- "Bachelor" in "Business and Commerce";
- "Bachelor" in "Business Informatics"; "Bachelor" in "Economics";
- "Professional Master" in "Banking and Insurance" (60 credits);
- "Professional Master" in "Tourist Guide" (60 credits);
- "Professional Master" in "Agrarian Engineering", Horticulture Profile (60 credits);
- "Professional Master" in "Quality and Food Safety" (60 credits);
- "Master of Science" in "Culture, Media and Editing".

The opening of new programs for this academic year aimed at increasing the number of students for the departments or faculties that were endangered as a result of the decrease in the number of students by setting the average grade according to the relevant DCM.

In 2019 it was applied for 2 study programs:

- "Executive Master" study program in "Management in Education";
- "Bachelor" study program in "Physical Education and Sports"; of which was it approved the "Bachelor" study program in "Physical Education and Sports".

In 2020 it was applied for 9 study programs (opening / reorganization):



- 2-year Professional Study Program "Computer systems and networks";
- 2-year Professional Study Program "Assistant Accountant";
- "Bachelor" Study Program in "Media and Philological Culture";
- "Bachelor" Study Program in "Primary Education Sciences" (reorganization);
- "Professional Master" Study Program in "Special Education for Inclusiveness";
- "Professional Master" in "Education and social service";
- "Master of Science" in "Information Technologies in Business";
- "Executive Master" in "Management in Education".

We emphasize the fact that MESY did not approve any of the proposed programs.

In 2021 it was applied for 3 study programs and the reorganization of 3 active programs:

- 2-year professional study program "Administrator in sales and services" (New study program);
- "Bachelor" study program in "Agribusiness Management" (reorganization);
- "Bachelor" study program in "Tourism Management and Hospitality" (reorganization);
- "Professional Master" study program in "Digital Marketing" (New study Program);
- "Professional Master" study program in "Teaching for Special Education and inclusiveness" (New study Program);
- "Professional Master" study program in "Tourism Management, Attractions and Events" (reorganization).

According to an overview of the curriculum development in the recent years, it can be seen that main units are extensively focusing on the requests for the change or opening of new study programs according to the labor market needs and national priorities. Regarding the legal changes, they have tried to meet the needs of the labor market and high school graduates to attend one of the study programs offered by "Fan S. Noli" University.

QUALITY ASSESSMENT



ACCREDITATION OF STUDY PROGRAMS

The accreditation process has placed the "Fan S. Noli University" in front of a challenge in meeting the requirements of the applicable law. The importance of this process is related to meeting the standards in quality assurance through external and internal mechanisms, involving a number of actors in this process.

"Fan S. Noli" University is continuously involved in all the processes for the internal quality assurance, but as a result of changes in legislation, in January 2017 it was involved in the process of institutional accreditation by the British Accreditation Agency QAA. This process served to assess the quality of the academic offer of "Fan S. Noli" University and it identified areas for improvement at the HEI level, and not only, preparing for the evaluation of study programs.

After the final evaluation by the Accreditation Board (DBA no. 65, dated 21. 09. 2017), which accredited the "Fan S. Noli" University for 5 years, measures were taken to meet the recommendations and the work continued on the accreditation of programs of study.

Based on the decision, taken by the Rectorate 282, dated 21.5.2019, the accreditation process for 9 study programs of the first cycle "Bachelor" and study programs of 2-year professional character:

- 1. "Bachelor" study program in "Agro-food";
- 2. "Bachelor" study program in "Agronomic Engineering";
- 3. "Bachelor" study program in "English Language";
- 4. "Bachelor" study program in " Teaching in Primary Education I-VI";
- 5. "Bachelor" study program in "Finance Accounting";
- 6. "Bachelor" study program in "Management";
- 7. "Bachelor" study program in "Administration and Social Policy";
- 8. "Bachelor" study program in "Biology-Chemistry";
- 9. 2-year Professional Study Program in "Education for infancy and early childhood".

The main units were involved in this new process by engaging all the staff and students in the internal and external evaluation of the quality of specific study programs. All the study programs have completed this process and some of them have received the maximum rating by the experts.

- "Bachelor" study program in "Management" (Accredited for 6 years);
- "Bachelor" study program in "Biology-Chemistry" (Accredited for 6 years);
- "Bachelor" study program in "English Language" (Accredited for 5 years).

All of the above mentioned have served to "Fan S. Noli" University as an institution and to the basic units to evaluate the academic offer, to identify strengths, weaknesses, recommendations and to further improve this offer through concrete measures.

The recommendations and tasks left by the first group of study programs for accreditation are being taken into account by the basic units in the second group of the study programs (13 study programs) applied for accreditation during April May 2021:

- 1. "Bachelor" study program in "Language-Literature";
- 2. "Bachelor" study program in "Business Administration in Marketing";
- 3. "Bachelor" study program in "History-Geography";

- 11. 2-year Professional Study Program "Assistant Manager";

Based on DBA no. 65, dated 21. 09. 2017 On the institutional accreditation of "Fan S. Noli University" the period of validity of the institutional accreditation is until 30. 09. 2022.

Based on the "Manual for procedures and deadlines for quality assessment within the accreditation of HEIs and study programs", the application for periodic accreditation will take place in October 2021. Preparatory work for the periodic accreditation has started by coordinating the work to provide the supporting documentation of the internal evaluation report and their translation by the structures in the Rectorate. After identifying the main documentation, a specific action plan will be drafted to coordinate the work performed on the ongoing process.

SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH

"Fan S. Noli" University considers the scientific research, as an integral part of its activity as an institution of higher education and at the same time as part of the further qualification of the academic staff.

For each academic year the University has undergone changes in the qualifications of full-time academic staff by increasing the level of qualification through obtaining Scientific Titles / Degrees.



The scientific activities of regional, national and international character, organized by CINIKO and relevant units during the period 2016-2020 are 78, of which 4 International Scientific Conferences, 11 National Scientific Conferences, 14 book promotions / presentations, 9 scientific seminars, 18 lectures, 2 workshops, 16 round tables, 4 scientific forums.

From the data collected from the analysis of the annual activities of each unit, it results that in the period 2016-2020:

- The academic staff of the Facultu of Agriculture has a decrease in participation in international conferences, while there is an increase in the number of participants in scientific symposia, seminars and trainings within the faculty.
- The academic staff of the Faculty of Education and Philology has a decrease in participation in international conferences, while there is an increase in the diversity of the scientific activities participating in two international congresses
- The academic staff of the Faculty of Economy has a decrease in participation in international conferences, while there is an increase in the diversity of scientific activities mainly participating in roundtables and open lectures under the students participation.
- The academic staff of the Faculty of Huan and Natural Sciences has had a significant consistency in participating in scientific activities, as well as in organizations within the faculty.

There is generally a consistency in terms of its periodical publication and an equally consistent distribution at the faculty level; the latter have published mainly the works of scientific activities organized by the unit itself. During these years, it has been noticed a lack of the publications of the

professors of the Faculty of Agriculture in the UNIKO Bulletin and studies in the fields of agricultural sciences as well. In the last issues of the Bulletin, the publication of articles in English has been encouraged in order to be prepared for applying at the international centers that give the right of impact factor.

The library of "Fan S. Noli" University provides about 30,000 books with over 12,000 titles belonging to different fields, but they are more focused on the field of market economy, agronomy and psycho-pedagogy. This fund is currently distributed in five facilities and respectively in:

- Scientific Library at the Rectorate;
- Library of the Faculty of Economics;
- Library of the Faculty of Agriculture;
- Library of the Faculty of Education and Philology;
- Library of the Faculty of Human and Natural Sciences

SWOT ANALYSIS

Strengths of "Fan S. Noli" University:

- 1. The only higher education institution that consistently operates in the south-eastern area of Albania for a period of 50 years, with 5-year institutional accreditation;
- 2. Successful start of the accreditation process of the Study Programs;
- 3. Geographical position at the junction of three countries (Albania-Greece-Northern Macedonia);
- 4. Facilities, infrastructure of modern information technology and scientific library for a normal development of teaching and research activity;
- 5. Laboratory infrastructure with a didactic and research direction;

- 6. Significantly high number of Secondary and Lower Education Institutions in the Region (about 300), which favors the Study Programs in Teaching Profile;
- 7. 99% stable academic and administrative staff in the last four years;
- 8. Sustainable and dynamic field of study and research in creating new directions of academic study:
- 9. Active participation in international projects (capacity building Erasmus +);
- 10. Significant participation in international projects (extensive cooperation at national and international level);
- 11. Effective organization of professional, institutional, clinical and sports practices of students in the fields of education, agriculture, economics, medicine, social sciences, etc.;
- 12. Involvement of students in decision-making, as full members of the Academic Senate, the Council of Ethics and the Internal Quality Assurance Units;
- 13. Periodic evaluation of the internal quality;
- 14. Experience gained from the Centers of Excellence, as a basic research and training unit for the continuous education;

Weaknesses:

- 1. Significant decrease in the population of the Korça Region and as a consequence it is noticed a decrease in the number of students in Primary and Secondary Education Institutions (about 29% less students in the period 2016-2020). This decrease is reflected in student registrations in the study programs.
- 2. General tendency of the graduates in certain study programs;
- 3. Unsatisfactory quality of student in some study programs;
- 4. Stagnation of the qualification of professors with scientific titles;
- 5. Inability to offer doctoral programs in the third cycle (doctoral studies) and delay in opening the third cycle study programs Executive Master;
- **6.** Limited mobility for students, academic and administrative staff. Lack of the deepened knowledge of foreign languages by the academic staff in general;
- 7. Narrow scope of applications in national and international projects from all faculties;
- 8. Lack of digital library and limited use of faculty libraries;
- 9. Lack of a suitable sports environment for curricular subjects and extracurricular activities;
- 10. Lack of a complete database for the employment of graduate students in years and the continuous connections with them;
- 11. Non-utilization of the full efficiency of the laboratories and equipment mainly obtained by the project funds;
- 12. 12. Stagnation of publications in the Bulletin of "Fan S. Noli" University;
- 13. 13. Lack of a complete strategy for promoting the academic offer;

14. 14. Limited cooperation with the stakeholders in the regional market and beyond.

Opportunities:

- 1. The location of "Fan S. Noli University" in the southeastern region of Albania, bordering two Balkan countries, offers opportunities for inviting students in the region and beyond, as well as for the exchange of experiences in the field of education and research;
- 2. Human and infrastructural capacities for opening executive master programs;
- 3. Experience of cooperation with foreign HEIs for the opening of joint programs, the increase of mobilities, the establishment of research centers and their enrichment with literature as well as the internationalization of the academic offer; membership in international academic networks;
- **4.** Extension of the range of modules offered by the Continuing Education Center in other areas, besides teaching;
- 5. Academic staff on the verge of qualification in the next cycle of scientific qualification;
- **6.** Integration processes, joint projects in which "Fan S. Noli" University is involved, create great opportunities for expanding cooperation with institutions inside and outside the region and beyond, in the field of teaching and research

Threats:

- 1. The general decrease in the number of births and consequently it is noticed a decrease of the number of the High School Graduates;
- 2. Low quality of incoming student-candidates coming from vocational high schools;
- 3. Lack of a map of the programs at the national level and lack of the national ranking of the Albanian HEIs, as well;
- 4. Changes in the budget definitions of the higher education fund;
- 5. The lack of a large employment market at the regional level, the lack of data on employment at the regional level and beyond, creates difficulties in the orientation of study programs and setting quotas in each program.

1.INSTITUTIONAL ORGANIZATION

In the framework of further institutional development and increase of the quality of services offered in "Fan S. Noli" University it is foreseen:

- Further consolidation of the sectors already approved in the organizational chart of "Fan S. Noli" University;
- Increasing and supporting the activity of the Internal Quality Assurance Unit;
- Consolidation of scientific research structures and academic publications at Faculty level;
- Increasing the activity of the Promotion and Career and Alumni Center;

- Increasing the range of lifelong learning modules offered by the Center of Continous Education.

2. TEACHING, CURRICULUM, ACADEMIC STAFF, INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE

TEACHING AND CURRICULUM

Regarding to teaching, in the following academic years it will be aimed to conduct a series of computer-based exams (alternatives). The purpose of computer-based exams is objectivity in assessment and transparency.

Initially, computer-based exams will be conducted in several courses of the First Cycle Study Programs: "Bachelor" in "General Nursing", "Bachelor" in "Midwifery" and "Bachelor" in

"Information Technology". In the following years this will be extended to other study proposed by "Fan S. Noli' University.

Another objective for the coming academic years is the consolidation of new teaching methods, especially for online learning.

Regarding the study programs it is aimed:

- Opening of new study programs, in particular study programs that close the study cycles (second cycle programs that are a continuation of the first cycle programs);
- Opening of Third Cycle Study Programs (Executive Master);
- Opening of joint study programs with international institutions;
- Fulfillment of legal obligations for all study programs in the framework of their accreditation according to legal provisions, as well as the fulfillment of reccomandations by the Accreditation Board for each study program;
- Strengthening current curricula;
- Market research study (in order for the data to be used for promotion as well as for bringing high school graduates attention towards the University);
- Expanding the focus of qualifications according to market needs;
- Encouraging the application of scientific findings in teaching activities;

An important part of the First Cycle Study Programs covered by "Fan S. Noli" University are study programs of teaching profile. "Fan S. Noli" University offers 9 study programs (Bachelor) of this profile:

- "Bachelor" in "Mathematics-Informatics"
- "Bachelor" in "Mathematics-Physics"
- "Bachelor" in "Biology-Chemistry"
- "Bachelor" in "Philosophy-Sociology"
- "Bachelor" in "Language-Literature"
- "Bachelor" in "History-Geography"
- "Bachelor" in "English Language"
- "Bachelor" in "Teacher for Preschool Education"
- "Bachelor" in "Teacher for Primary Education"

There are about 300 Institutions of Pre-school Education, Primary Education and Secondary Education. This high number shows the importance of the study programs of teaching profile at "Fan S. Noli" University.

In the last 4 years there have been a significant decrease in the number of students enrolled in these study programs. The factors that have influenced this phenomenon are mainly: the average grade of candidates, the oversupply of the labor market and the decline in the number of structure primary and secondary schools.

The strategy of our university during the period 2020-2027 for the consolidation of study programs of teaching profile will be based on the four points below:

•Continuous contact with Secondary Education students

This will be achieved through various activities that will also include students of Higher Secondary Education from Korça region and beyond.

"Rroke Shkencën" Olympiad

Students of Higher Secondary Education schools of Korça Region participate in this Olympiad participate the students of the Higher Secondary Education schools of Korça Region. It is based on students' group work (5 representative students from each high school). In the next 4 years we will add some profiles in this Olympiad, in order to include most of the profiles related to teaching offered by the University. The profiles of the Olympiad will be: mathematics, informative technology, physics, biology, chemistry, language-literature and social sciences. The Olympiad will be organized and managed by the respective profiles' departments and will include students of these study programs.

• Various trainings offered for students of Secondary Education by the academic staff of the University

Every year, during the period January-May the academic staff of the Uiversity will provide short-term trainings for graduate students of Higher Secondary Education to help them with the State Matura exams. These trainings aim to introduce these students with "Fan S. Noli" staff and to bring their attention towards studying at "Fan S. Noli"

ACADEMIC STAFF

In the following years, for the academic staff of the university it is aimed:

- Consolidation of internal/external academic staff ratio;
- Further promotion of the academic staff qualification for scientific titles and degrees;
- Encouraging the academic staff to consolidate scientific research and to apply research findings in teaching activities;
- Encouraging the academic staff to participate more in programs or projects of common interest.

•INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE

In terms of quality assurance the University focuses on two divisions: internal quality assurance and external quality assurance. The University has already developed the Internal Quality Assurance system, which supports its activity in three pillars: assurance, control and quality assessment. The Internal

Quality Assurance Unit which supports and provides expertise is also part of this sytem. External quality assurance includes taking measures to complete the processes of institutional accreditation and accreditation of study programs.

University's strategy for the period 2020-2027 for quality assurance is focused on the following main objectives:

- Carrying out quality evaluation for institutional accreditation and evaluation for accreditation of study programs
- Taking measures for the processes of institutional accreditation and accreditation of study programs
- Meeting quality assurance standards
- Quality control and enhancement through appropriate actions and measures
- Quality assurance of services and infrastructure

3. INFRASTRUCTURE, SERVICES, PROMOTION

Infrastructure

Regarding the University infrastructure, it is aimed:

- Creating the necessary facilities for consolidating the student/m² ratio;
- Establishment of laboratories in function of teaching;
- Implementation of physiotherapy laboratory;
- Renovation with the necessary literature of the faculty libraries and the scientific library;
- Construction of an additional building at the Faculty of Natural and Human Sciences (on the foundations of the existing library building).

SERVICES

One of the main objectives for the academic year 2021-2022 is the restructured teaching secretary team. This includes the amalgamation of all secretaries of the 4 faculties of the university, and the creation of a central secretary team in charge of teaching and a central secretary team in charge for the electronic system. Within this structure students will receive all the necessary services (certifications, payments, etc.).

Another objective is the creation of a new website through which students and the interested indviduals will receive all the information on the study programs and the studies and current academic year progress.

PROMOTION

Promotion as a communication means and process between what the university offers and the potential students should be considered as an important part that can help increase the quantitative and qualitative inflows of students. To increase the promotional activities efficiency, the University will be focused on these main objectives, which will be converted into concrete activities:

- Drafting the institutional promotion strategy;
- Active involvement of departments;
- Involvement of of job market representatives;
- Inclusion of current and graduate students;
- Establishment of the advisory board;
- Updating promotional materials;
- Organizing promotional activities best presentating what the University offers.

4. SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH AND INNOVATION

In defining strategic objectives in the field of research "Fan S. Noli" University takes into consideration the principle of research freedom, the principle of research ethics, the principle of professional responsibility, legal obligations and financial responsibility, which are all principles that guide research activity for the good of humanity and the expansion of scientific brders. This aims to improve the scientific research content with a focus on quality teaching, adaptation to national priorities and increasement of independent research ability in function of sustainable development.

Approximation of institutional objectives with national ones for the research and technology sector, in aspects that are related to the quality of research, research-scientific infrastructure, applied research conducted at social level, connection of research with teaching.

- The primary goal of research at "Fan S. Noli" University is increasing the teaching quality considering its findings as an integral part of the qualifications offered by the university curriculum.
- Research is also considered part of the promotion of academic staff, as researchers and innovators, in a broader social, conomic, regional, national and international context.

Research priorities:

- Increasing the research activity in faculties and its standardization with the principles of research ethics;
- Increasing the publishing activity of the academic staff (financial support of international publications);
- Involvement of students in research;
- Cnnection of research with university curricula and qualifications;
- Encouragement of national and international cooperation in applied research;

- Increasing the influence of UNIKO in the region, as an institution that offers specialized expertise in the fields of agriculture, education, economy, natural, human and health sciences in support of national priorities;
- Full usage of the research structure capacities in the respective units, in order to enable qualified services to third parties.

5.INTERNATIONALIZATION OF THE ACADEMIC OFFER

Focusing on the international partnership in teaching and research, as well as increasing the cooperation forms with other HEIs or institutional networks of higher education, in terms of international presence in the research and teaching process that is conducted in the institution, in publications of academic staff, as well as exchanges within study and teaching periods.

Currently "Fan S. Noli" University has 127 active agreements with partner institutions in the Balkans and in Europe. It is a member of these academic networks: ASECU, AUF, UNIMED, AURORA CDS, BUA.

Cooperation agreements:

During the period 2016-2020, 120 cooperation agreements are signed as follows:

1 28 international agreements with foreign HEIs with the main objective:

- participation in scientific activities organized by each university;
- joint organization of scientific activities;
- exchange of scientific materials, literature and books;
- joint publications;
- exchange of experience between academic, administrative staff and students;
- joint participation in projects;
- creating opportunities for joint study programs;
- cultural exchange, etc.

2 35 national agreements with HEIs (11), associations, organizations, centers, institutes, various institutions (24) with the main objective:

- exchanges in function of institutional and inter-institutional development;
- exchange of academic staff for the teaching process;
- exchange of professors, researchers and students for teaching and research activities;
- encouraging, supporting and implementing joint research projects; promotion, support and implementation of other scientific activities (conferences, seminars and publications in areas of common interest);

- exchange of scientific literature, books, scientific publications, academic projects and information on courses, conferences, seminars and databases of common interest;
- joint publishing contracts if there is a common interest; organization of joint social and cultural activities;
- exchange of experience related to the management of the institution, etc.

3 57 national agreements signed for stdents' internships.

These agreements have been signed with various institutions, organizations and businesses according to the profile of the study programs that the University offers and the needs for students' internships. Most of them are signed at faculty level and are closely related to the profile of the faculties and the profile of the institutions/businesses with which the agreements are signed. The main objective of these agreements include:

- creating real opportunities for students to conduct professional practice at these institutions/ organizations/businesses;
- organizing and engaging in joint projects and activities of regional level;
- conducting lectures, round tables, training seminars with the participation of directors and specialists of these institutions and students;
- exchange of experience and expertise;
- each party provides facilities in the framework of research and study, with the aim to engage students in research;
- bringing students closer to the labor market and thus facilitating their future employment process through pre-established contacts between employers'/organizations/institutions/businesses and the University/students through interaction during professional internships;
- any other activity of common interest.

The main objective of the above-mentioned is to create a credibility and professionalism profile related to teaching, research and international cooperation within the framework of development and capacity building projects mutually.

Main directions

- 1. Concrete international partnership and cooperation;
- 2. Joint study programs and long-term mobilities;
- 3. Joint scientific research according to international standards.

The internationalization of the academic offer in the next five years aims at its promotion in a wider academic network, aiming at promoting concrete partnership mainly in increasing the quality of scientific research, in the sustainability of diplomas offered on an international market, promoting and increasing the visibility of the academic achievements of academic staff and students through

quality institutional publications, organization of joint scientific activities, participation in projectsideas in order to increase institutional capacity and their direct impact on the social and economic development of the region.

The International Relations Sector as a supporting administrative structure creates new interuniversity exchange links through:

- identification of international HEIs that offer opportunities for cooperation;
- deepening and diversifying UNIKO cooperation with strategic partners in the Balkans and Europe, in terms of the above-mentioned;
- encouraging the exchange of students, researchers and academic staff;
- coordination of processes for offering dual degree diplomas;
- membership in academic networks and strengthening of the position in the networks ASEC,
 AUF, UAMID of which the University is a member already;
- application in international project programs such as: Erasmus+, Horizon 2020, CBC, Mari Curie Scolarships, Fullbright Scholarship, etc.;
- coordination of procedures for the establishment of joint study and research centers;
- increasing the communication with the academic diaspora, alumni and former academic staff that are employed in international HEIs.

1 Joint study programs and long-term mobilities

Offering joint study programs, with the main focus on programs of second and third cycle, aims to increase the quality of qualification offered by the curriculum, the sustainability of diplomas offered in a wider market of the European area, as well as the promotion of academic experience of staff.

- in-depth studies of professional qualifications in the international market, focusing on professions of the future;
- encouraging inter-institutional cooperation, in common academic fields similar to the abovementioned;
- identification of real capacities in each faculty for joint programs and applied research;
- updating the Erasmus+ Course Catalog for international students and encouraging mobility;
- detailing the legal and financial framework that facilitates credit recognition and transfer procedures of staff/student mobility;
- drafting international programs/trainings/short-term summer schools for staff, students, alumni and stakeholders.

2 Joint scientific research according to international standards

- encouraging the organization of joint international scientific activities; standardization of procedures and their documentation;
- drafting stimulating policies for the participation of staff and students in research activities abroad;
- establishment of joint research and study centers and updating the literature resources available to research staff;
- increase of the Scientific Bulletin quality through the expansion of its Scientific Board with members from partner universities; its publication in English language and application for international indexing;
- encouragement for scientific publications in indexed journals that are internationally recognized;
- involving students in research and creating bridges with international partners for the organization of scientific activities;
- including online teaching in the university curriculum and the increase of programs offered in the form of "blended learning";
- fostering entrepreneurship and innovation spaces/qualifications in the university curriculum.

6. STUDENTS

The University aims to create an inspiring environment for enrolled students and those who are expected to be enrolled in the future by offering quality and professional commitment that meets their best expectations. In this regard, the University will be based on several main objectives:

- Improving student support services to increase the quality of studies and student life;
- Creating an inspiring work and learning environment, focusing on student-centered teaching, as a way to empower the student in all forms of education, providing the best solution for sustainable and flexible learning ways;
- Organizing activities which are directly related to students and increasing the quality of social and artistic life of students;
- Expansion of the Alumni network and collection of data on the professional progress of individuals who have completed their studies at "Fan S. Noli" University and organizing activities and meetings with graduate students.
