The conference will be held in Bitola, at **the Faculty of Education – Bitola** (address: Vasko Karangjelevski, bb, 7000 Bitola, RN Macedonia) on **October 3rd - 4th, 2025**.

Hence, 6th Education Across Borders Conference 2025 (EABC): **Reimagining Education in the Modern Age** (REMA) encourages contributions which discuss and explore new pathways for educators, institutions, and policymakers to ensure learners are not only fully equipped with knowledge but also with the skills needed to thrive in this dynamic and ever-changing world.

• The role of educators in a tech-driven world: How will the role of teachers shift in this new landscape, and how can they receive better support in adapting to these changes?

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# **Technical guidelines for full paper submission (paper template)**

Authors are required to submit full papers following the technical guidelines outlined below. Papers that do not adhere to these guidelines may be returned for correction or rejected outright.

- 1. Paper Format
- File format: The paper should be submitted as a Word document (.doc or .docx)
- Page size: A4 (210 mm x 297 mm).
- Margins: 1 inch (2.54 cm) on all sides.
- Single Line spacing.
- Font: Times New Roman, size 12 for the body text.
- Paragraph alignment: Justified.
- Each paragraph of the introduction should be indented to the right by 0.5 inch or 1.27 cm.

# 2. Length

- Full papers should be 8 to 14 pages in length, including references, figures, and appendices.
- 3. Title and Author Information
- Title: Centered, bold, in Times New Roman, size 12. Use ALL CAPITAL LETTERS.
- Author(s): Listed below the title, centered, in Times New Roman, size 12. Include the first and last names of the authors, followed by their affiliations and email addresses.
- 4. Abstract and Keywords
- Include an abstract of 250 words, summarizing the key points of the paper. The abstract should be followed by 3 to 5 keywords relevant to the paper's content.
- Abstract font size: 12, justified.
- Keywords font size: 12, normal.
- 5. Headings and Subheadings
- Main headings: Bold, Times New Roman, size 12. Numbered (1, 2, 3, etc.).
- Subheadings: Bold, Italicized, Times New Roman, size 12. Numbered hierarchically (1.1, 1.2, etc.).
- 6. Figures and Tables
- All figures, tables, and illustrations should be centered, numbered sequentially (e.g., Figure 1, Table 1), and referenced in the text.
- Figure/Table titles: Centered below the figure/table, in Times New Roman, size 10.
- Ensure high-resolution images and clarity in tables or graphs.
- 7. In-text Citations and References
- Use the APA style (7th edition) for both in-text citations and the reference list.
- In-text citations should include the author's last name and the year of publication (e.g., Smith, 2023).
- The reference list should appear at the end of the document, in alphabetical order by the authors' last names, using Times New Roman, size 12.
- 8. Submission Deadline
- Full papers must be submitted no later than 30th November, 2025.
- 9. Submission Portal
- All submissions must be made via the conference's submission portal: rema2025@uklo.edu.mk
