The conference will publish a **Book of Proceedings** containing all the peer-reviewed full papers accepted for presentation. The Book of Proceedings will be made available online as a soft copy, accessible to all participants and the wider research community.

Additionally, a **Book of Abstracts** summarizing all accepted contributions will be printed in hard copy and distributed to attendees during the conference.

SUBMISSION AND PUBLICATION PROCESS

All submitted papers will undergo a rigorous peer-review process. Accepted full papers will be published in the online proceedings, while abstracts will be compiled into the printed Book of Abstracts.
