When listing the test on your website, or other materials outlining English requirements, please list as: **LANGUAGECERT Academic (including Online)**

If your institution does not accept online delivery, then please list as:
LANGUAGECERT Academic (in-person)

If your institution has programmes or courses that require a UKVI SELT (taken at a UKVI-approved test centre) please list as: **LANGUAGECERT Academic UKVI SELT**

Listing LANGUAGECERT Academic Entry Requirements

Please use this guide to set LANGUAGECERT Academic minimum score requirements at your institution.

State the minimum required scores for LANGUAGECERT Academic

Example:

LANGUAGECERT Academic: Overall score of 70, with no less than 65 in each skill
